

ABOUT THE WEEKEND...

The Encounter Weekend is part of the discipleship structure at Clark Fork City Church. It is not meant to “stand alone” or to be another activity or program within the church. To run it as such is to miss the point of the retreat and to minimize its effectiveness.

The Encounter Weekend is for believers who attend CFCC (as well as guests) and is just one of the many components in the ongoing discipling process of the believer. The believer is encouraged to attend a Small Group where relationships are formed that promote the building up of one another in love.

Being helped and helping others. This is the pattern of the New Testament Church.

At the Encounter Weekend attendees will have the opportunity to deal with the sins and issues of their past in a safe and quiet setting. A sponsor will lead the attendee through each ministry session following a brief teaching on the topic at hand.

Following the retreat, the growing believer is encouraged to attend several other components in their

maturing and discipling process. Other teaching and equipping and discipling components will follow, all designed to help the believer grow and mature.

James 5:16 Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.

1 Thes. 5:9-11 For God did not appoint us to suffer wrath but to receive salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ. He died for us so that, whether we are awake or asleep, we may live together with him. Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just in fact you are doing.

ENCOUNTER WEEKENDS

Friday evening, Saturday and Sunday

Purpose: To take believers through a “fast-track” process of “inner healing” and deliverance; to instill, inspire and motivate the desire for growth and maturity into the image of Christ, and to equip and train Sponsors to minister healing to others.

Topics: God’s Plan For Your Life; Forgiveness; Sins of the Fathers & Curses; Generational, Occult, and Sexual Sins; Soul Ties; Rejection; Hearts of Stone; Inner Vows; Bitterroot Judgments and Expectancies; Ungodly Beliefs; The Father’s Blessing; and Pressing On.

Method: Interactive – Short teaching times followed by interaction and ministry between Sponsor and Attendee.

Definitions

Sponsor: Previous Encounter Weekend attendee who leads attendee through one-on-one ministry sessions.

Attendee: First time attendee. Attendee may select Sponsor of choice or request that one be assigned him/her.
